British Values at Pownall Green Primary School

The Department for Education published updated guidance in 2014 on promoting British values in schools, in order to ensure that young people leave school prepared for life in modern Britain.

Pownall Green recognises its duty to prepare its pupils for life in modern Britain – that living in a local, national and international community will require them to both understand and appreciate difference, whilst maintaining a shared sense of the structures that are needed to keep individuals and community safe.

At Pownall Green we communicate the 'British Values' in a child friendly way using the following terms.

We value:

Tolerance: we accept that people from different cultures may hold different beliefs.

Respect: we respect the opinions of others and treat them in a kind way.

Democracy: we believe in fairness.

Individual liberty: we are free to make our own choices.

The rule of law: we understand the consequences of our actions.

Equality: we treat everybody equally.

Kindness: we try to help others and are thankful to those who keep us safe (*respect for authorities*).
