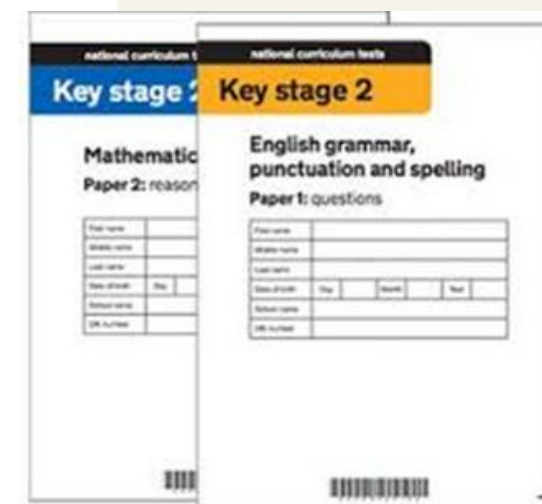




KS2 SATs

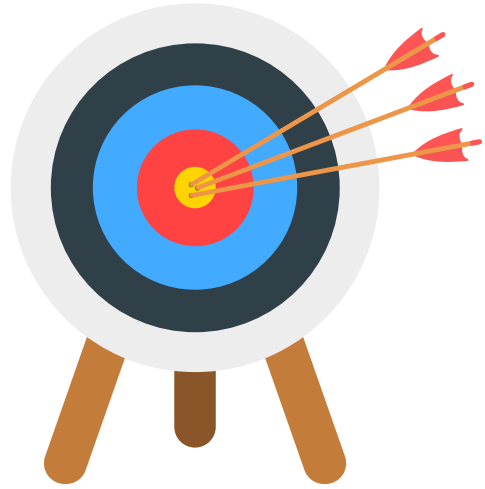


- If children are allowed to leave the classroom on their own, please email admin@pownallgreen.co.uk

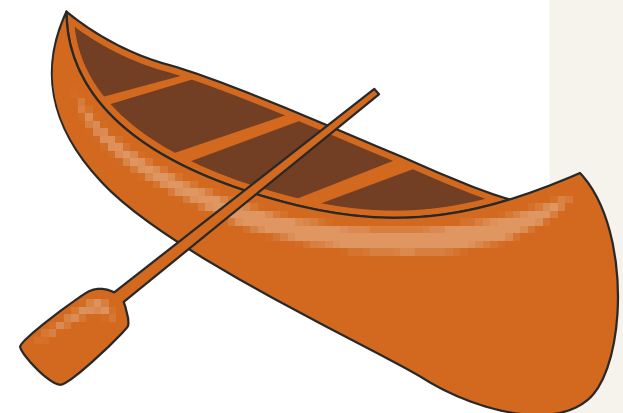
Robinwood
