
Pownall Green Primary School Extra Curricular Activities 2025/26

Sewing Club is designed to help children explore new ways of using their creative ideas and expressing them through a series of hand embroidery and sewing projects.

Every half term we try a different type of project. This includes learning new stitches, using different fabric types and changing from 2D to 3D projects. All sewing projects are based on the principle that we design them ourselves on paper first. This way, children learn to develop their design skills as well as their sewing skills.
